Text Coding Method

- Automated coding was conducted using NVIVO 2.0, an ethnographic qualitative analysis program
- The goal of automated coding was to analyze all available qualitative data—final reports, dissemination products, and interviews—in order to identify outcomes both at the individual project and cross-cutting level

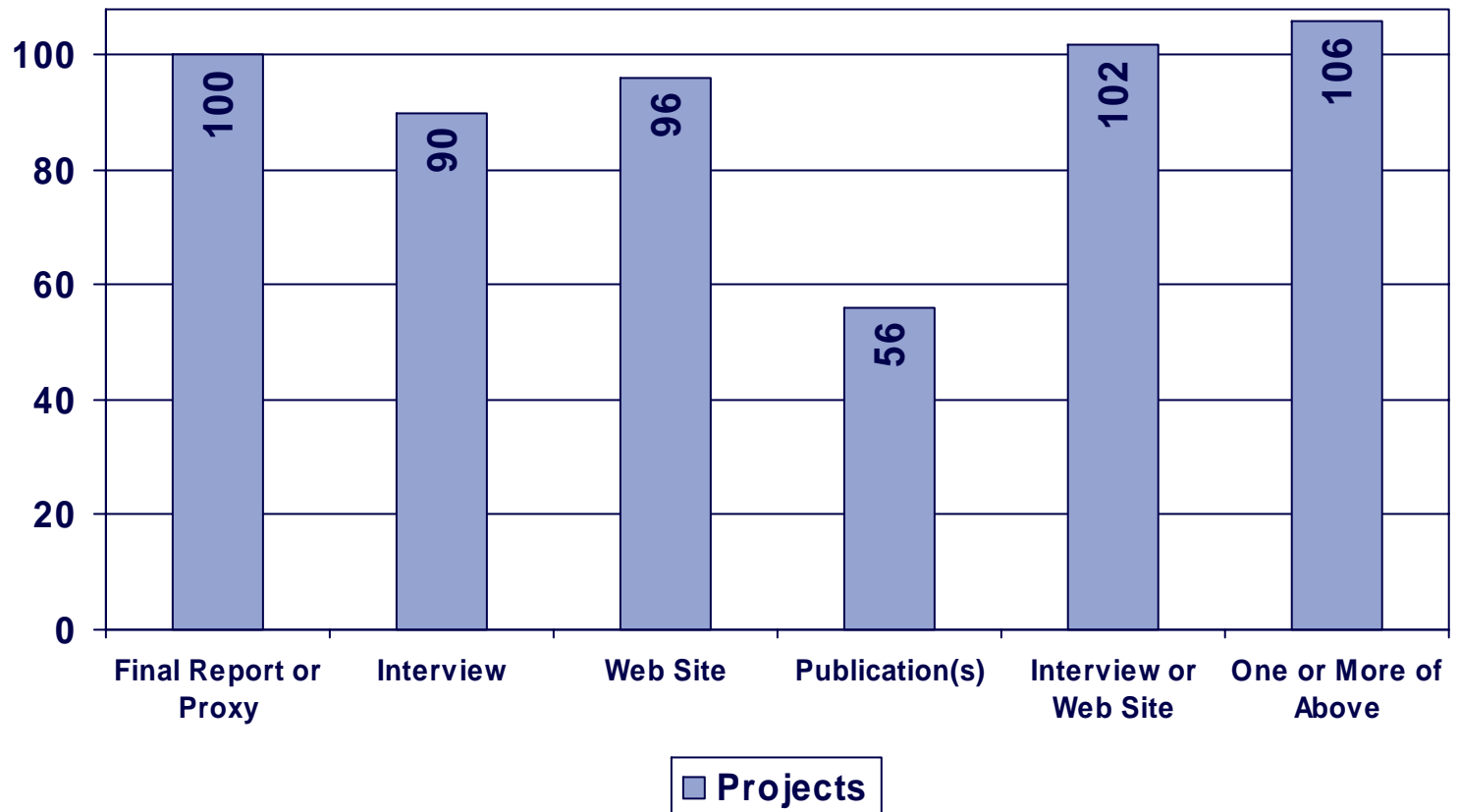

Data Available from Various Sources

- Final Reports and Proxies
 - 100 of 108 Projects had detailed text description files from project final reports and/or supplemental materials and/or publications on the project model
 - Optical character recognition on paper reports was very time consuming
- Web Descriptions in November 2003
 - 96 of 108 Projects or their parent organizations had web sites from which project-relevant materials could be extracted
- Interviews in Late 2003 and Early 2004
 - At least one representative from 90 of 108 projects was interviewed
- Publications as of Late 2003
 - At least one scientific publication was found for 56 of 108 projects
 - Databases searched included Medline and PsycINFO as well as appendices to grant reports
